Year 5 Newsletter

Spring Term 2: 2017



This half term our topic is related to 'changes around us'.

The children will be learning about the following:

- **English**– This term we continue with arguments and debates by looking at the pros and cons of fracking. We move onto journalistic writing and explore environmental changes: by writing a news report on the effects of flooding in the UK. We will also be examining classic narrative and Oral poems.
- **Maths**– This term, we will be focusing on a variety of different aspects. We have already looked at multiplication and division of whole numbers and decimals, rounding up to a million, negative numbers as well as place value. For the rest of the term, we will be learning about measuring and comparing angles; position and direction; and statistics.
- **Science** – Our topic for this term will be forces; we will look at balanced/unbalanced forces, gravity, air resistance, friction and water resistance.
- **Geography**- We will be looking at 'How our country is changing? We will focus on identifying the regions and the main topographical features in the UK. Furthermore, we will examine how the Olympics has changed the landscape of London. Children will also look at the changes to the Blackburn areas.

- **Patchworks**- in DT this term we are looking at patchworks and how they tell a story. They are created by piecing together many patches to create a big patchwork quilt piece. We will be looking ways to stitch and embellish our patches and base our pieces on the geographical areas of Blackburn.
- **Spellings**- Hyphens to join prefix words
- **ICT** - 'We are web developers' children will be creating web page on online safety.
- **French**- We shall be learning about 'The return of spring'. Children will learn how to say the seasons and describe their feelings and create a mood board on the changes in the different seasons.
- **RE**- The topic this term for RE will be change and death; we believe that children should be aware of the different stages throughout a person's life. In this unit we plan on teaching children that death is not always a bad thing and it is a way that we can celebrate someone's life.

What you can do at home:

- Read with your child every day. This will increase their fluency and will assist them in their comprehension.
- Encouraging them to use ambitious vocabulary in their writing and use a dictionary for homework.
- Assist your child in learning their times tables with the corresponding division facts.
- Encourage your child with their handwriting so it becomes legible and joined.
