As part of our English curriculum, we have booked an exciting trip for our pupils to visit the Titanic exhibition at Maritime Museum in Liverpool.

Our pupils will experience the fascinating journey through many little-known aspects of the Titanic disaster and explore Liverpool's central role in the Titanic story through the compelling exhibition 'Titanic and Liverpool: the untold story'. Told from perspectives of key personnel in the drama, it gives a unique insight into events surrounding the launch, voyage, sinking and its aftermath.

Furthermore, our pupils will also visit the famous Museum of Liverpool in conjunction with the Industrial Revolution unit we have been studying in history. At the museum, The Great Port outlines how Liverpool became one of the world's great ports and how this shaped the city of today. The gallery will aim to equip pupils with research skills to investigate Liverpool's port history, its links to the Industrial Revolution and to question the impact of technological advancements on our lives.

Finally, the pupils will have an opportunity to undertake a stroll at the Albert Docks. Iconic in style; immense in ambition. Liverpool's docks dominated global trade in the 19th century, with the Albert Dock at their heart. It will be a memorable trip for our pupils!
